How to Recycle in Lauderdale

Recycling is collected in Lauderdale every week on Monday.

Wheel your recycling cart to the edge of the curb or alley by 7 a.m. every Monday (or the night before) with the lid opening facing the street or alley.

The cart should not be placed in the **street or in the alley.** Please make sure to leave two feet of space all the way around your cart to allow us to collect it safely with our automatic trucks- do not place your cart right next to a fence, garage, trash cart, or any other object.

Mark your calendar! Due to holidays, your recycling will be collected on the following Tuesdays in 2023: May 30, **September 5, and December 26.** MAY **SEPTEMBER DECEMBER** 26


