How to Recycle in ROSEVILLE

Recycling cart must be at the curb by 7 a.m. with the lid opening facing the street. The city of Roseville requests all recycling carts be stored out of view from the street on non-recycling days.

For holidays falling on a weekday during your recycling week, collections on and following the holiday will be delayed by one day.

must be flattened and small enough to fit in the cart



Milk Cartons and Juice Boxes
rinse clean, replace caps



Newspaper
with inserts



Most Plastic Food and Beverage Containers
empty, rinse, put caps or lids back on when you can
#1, #2 & #5 accepted



Magazines, Mail, Phonebooks, Office Paper



Boxboard
pop and beer boxes, too!
Please remove plastic liners or bags, flatten



Glass Bottles and Jars
rinse clean, remove caps and lids



Steel & Aluminum Cans, Aerosol Cans, Foil and Trays
rinse clean, labels are OK

No!

Don't place these items in your recycling cart



NO PLASTIC BAGS
DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLING

- Aerosol cans that contained hazardous materials
- Batteries (all types)
- Black plastic
- Bulky items, containers larger than 3 gallons
- Ceramic or pottery
- Clothes & linens
- Cords, wires, hoses & holiday lights
- Disposable cups, plates, utensils
- Electronics & appliances
- Freezer boxes
- Light bulbs
- Meal delivery kit insulation
- Packaging from toys or electronics

- Plant pots
- Plastic bags & film plastic
- Plastics labeled #3, #6, or #7
- Pots, pans, dishes
- Propane tanks or other fuel tanks/bottles
- Scrap metal
- Sharps containers
- Shipping envelopes w/ any plastic
- Shredded paper
- Styrofoam™
- Tissue paper and napkins
